2024 Annual City of Centerville Lighted Christmas Parade Rules & Information


- 1. All entries must be lighted.
- 2. 2024 Parade Theme: "'Twas the Light Before Christmas"
- 3. The parade will be livestreamed on The City of Centerville's Facebook page.
- 4. Judging will occur as the parade passes the Judges Reviewing Stand located in front of Center Park. Judging will be based on interpretation of the theme, creativity, overall appearance and use of lights.
- 5. Winners will be notified the following week and awards presented at the city council meeting December 17, 2024.
- 6. The parade route will run in reverse this year. The parade will start by Exiting onto Houston Lake Rd via the Galleria Mall Entrance. The parade will continue North on Houston Lake Road, turn left onto Thomson St and End at the corner of Thomson St and Houston Lake Blvd.
- 7. Parade entries can begin arriving at 4:00pm.
- 8. All Entries, (Floats, Vehicles, Trailers, etc.) should be at the staging area by 5 pm and should arrive via Margie Drive at the North Entrance to the Galleria Mall (across from El Cotija. The staging area is on Matt Kenne Cir. (behind Galleria Mall).
- 9. All participants, (Walkers, Riders, Drivers, etc.) should be at the staging area and at their parade entry by 530 pm.
- 10. Centerville Police and Fire Departments will oversee line-up and execution of the parade. These departments will have full authority regarding your placement and your complete cooperation is expected.
- 11. The Group Leader / Driver listed above will be responsible for insuring staging area is clean from trash and debris. The Group Leader / Driver is responsible for briefing all participants and must remain with their group throughout the parade. Their duties also include ensuring that children are not left unattended or unsupervised, preventing them from wandering around staging areas, and ensuring they do not leave the staging area without adult supervision. It is mandatory for the Group Leader / Driver to attend a safety meeting, failure to do so will result in disqualification of the group.
- 12. Safety Meeting Attendance is Mandatory for all Drivers and Group Leaders on Monday, December 2nd at 6:00pm at Centerville City Hall.
- 13. There will only be one (1) Santa Claus provided by Centerville in the parade.
